In an unprecedented move, the Cook County Board of Review has agreed to accept 2007 appeals for any property in the county if the taxpayer can demonstrate that its fair market value has decreased since January 1, 2007.

This new open window for appeals begins Monday, March 17 and ends Monday, March 31.
